#### Lion's Tooth

Strong, fruity, good cooler


Beeswax washed Ketel One Vodka, Granny Smith & Crab Apple Home-made Cordial, Dandelion Infused Pommeau & Apple Leather

Inspired by the bright yellow colour of the dandelion flower which is a symbol of growth, hope and healing. The word, dandelion, is from the French "dent-de-lion" which means lion's tooth.

Blending this flower with honey wax washed vodka and apples gives a mildly sweet taste and makes a sophisticated gimlet with orchard fruit & floral notes.

The apple waste from juicing is used to make the apple leather garnish.





Bitter, earthy, aromatic

Tanqueray No. Ten, Belsazar White Vermouth, Amaro Santoni, Pink Grapefruit & Raspberry Shrub

The origins of the word Botanic derives from the Greek word botanikos, "of herbs." The name is inspired by the unique blend of precious botanicals which brings a delicate and complex touch to the palate. With medium intense spiciness plus herbaceous and floral notes, followed by citrus and bitter sensations.

This is a truly unique and deliciously exciting bitter-sweet drink.





## The Blessing Grounds

Aperitif, refreshing, fruity, herbal notes

Mulberry & Strawberry Infused Rose Wine, Mancino Amaranto, Citrus Rinomato Aperitivo, Perrier Sparkling Water & Fried Basil Leaf

Basil is a certainly tasty little plant, but it's suffered a symbolism identity crisis over the years. Originally meaning "hate," it later became embraced as a symbol of love. During the Victorian era sweet basil conveyed "good wishes" to the receiver.

A lovely, dry and fragrant drink with orange peel aromas and forest fruit. Elements of Sauvignon Blanc, which typically has earthy and herbal notes of grass, make it a refreshing highball, elevated with berries and citrus.

We reuse all orange leftovers to make the infusion. We also reuse the infused strawberries to make a strawberry leather.





#### Rose

Refreshing, floral, fruity

Red Berry Leaf Infused Ciroc Vodka, Belsazar Rose Vermouth, Maraschino Cherries, Citrus, Laurent Perrier Brut, Wine & Rose water Foam,
Red Berries Dust

Symbolizing romance, love, beauty and courage, the red rose is synonymous with purity and passion.

Rose takes inspiration from its namesake, bringing forth sweet subtle undertones of strawberries and berries through the infusion of the berry leaf. The addition of Belsazar Rosé adds departing notes of summer fruits, orange blossom and pink grapefruit.



## Spring Gardens

Floral and velvety texture

Butterfly Pea Flower infused Ramsbury Gin, White Port, Italicus Rosolio of Bargamot, Home-made Lavender Syrup, Citrus & Aquafaba

Inspired by our Spring Gardens location which was home to an incredible selection of wildflowers, this cocktail embodies everything that our local garden represents.

The Spring Gardens were also thought to be home to pheasants and wild fowl alongside exotic fruits and woodland. Woody tones are present from the pea flower, while the port brings a freshness alongside sweet citrus and honey. Italicus gives subtle light and bitter notes with a floral, spicy finish.



## **Ephemeral Beauty**

Intense, sweet, tropical

Coconut Washed Matusalem Platino, Matusalem 15Yr old Rum infused Tonka Bean, Caramelised Pineapple, Hibiscus flower bitters

The hibiscus flower is the state flower of Hawaii and it is presented as a welcome gift to visiting state officials and tourists, often in the form of a necklace. Dating back to the Victorian era, when flowers adorned fashion, hibiscus means "delicate beauty," relating to the sunny and delicate conditions under which it will bloom.

The flavours take inspiration from its namesake, bringing forth sweet subtle undertones of coconut and caramelised pineapple through the infusion of Tonka, alongside the addition of 15yr old Rum.





## Electric Daisy

Electric, acidic, smooth texture

Bulleit Bourbon & Rémy Martin 1738 infused with mandarin marmalade & saffron, Mancino Secco Vermouth, Chamomile Cordial, Electric Daisy Bitters, Citrus & Aquafaba

Symbolizing innocence and purity, it is believed that the daisy gets its name from the Old English phrase "daes eage," or "day's eye," because of the way the flower blossoms at the first sign of dawn. Daisies have been around since 2,200 B.C., when the ancient Egyptians grew them for medicinal use.

Be prepared, our Electric Daisy brings a sharp but smooth sensation.





#### New York Nettle

Clarified, menthol cooler

Torres 15Yr Old infused with Hay & Straw, Kummel macerated with Peppermint leaf, Citrus & Cadello 88

Mint is a symbol of hospitality and wisdom.

This is a clarified punch with inspiration taken from the cocktail, Stinger, an after-dinner cocktail popular in 1890's New York City, and quickly became known as a "Society" drink for the upper classes.

We hand cut hay from our own species-rich 'micro-meadow' from a local nature reserve which has just the right composition of species to get the flavours we want. The punch than takes influence from the exotic herbs and spices found in Cadello 88 to deliver a harmonious, flavoursome drink with a silky delivery.



#### Fearless Green Grounds

Fruity, earthy, acidic

Altos Blanco Tequila, Prickly Pear, Cactus Liqueur, Grapefruit Bitters Served with Del Maguey Mezcal & Orchid Lime Caviar

Native American cultures believe that the cactus represents warmth, protection, and motherly love because cacti plants can survive in harsh conditions and they've become a symbol of unconditional, maternal love.

The pulp from the prickly pear fruit is extracted from the plant which is then sieved and fermented with the addition of a yeast species.

The inspiration of this drink comes from its own name. A cactus doesn't live in the desert because it likes the desert; it lives there because the desert hasn't killed it yet.



Yasmin

Blooming, floral flavours

Suntory Toki Whisky, Yuzu Puree, Cold Brew Jasmine Tea Soda, Served with Yuzu puree & Jasmine Air with Wheat

The word jasmine is derived from the Arabic word "yasmin," which means fragrant flower. The jasmine flower symbolizes love, purity, modesty, hospitality, community and spiritual ascension.

The fragrance of jasmines and yuzu fruits is unbeatable. Blending it with Japanese Whiskey makes it an incredible experience. The sweetness from the flowers creates a delicious atmosphere and flavour, giving the perfect Japanese highball with beautiful floral notes.






## Pistachio Refreshing, floral, nutty

Suntory Roku Gin, Mancino Sakura, Lime, Yuzu Soda, Tia Maria Matcha & Pistachio Sorbet

While cherry blossoms are a symbolic flower of the spring, a time of renewal, and the fleeting nature of life, matcha uplifts the spirit and brings the mind and body into harmony, whilst nourishing your health.

Matcha is vibrant, fresh & flavourful, bursting with floral aromas, a thick creamy texture and the right balance of sweetness. These deep umami flavours pair beautifully with the pistachio. The silky texture of floral notes and nutty flavours provides a natural and refreshing experience.





Smoky and powerful

Macallan 12Yr Double Cask infused Roasted Cacao Beans, Belsazar Red Vermouth, Amaro Montenegro, Vanilla & Tobacco Bitters

The naturally occurring qualities of cocoa have been used in cigarettes for years for its influence on sensory qualities. They would use the cocoa to impact the taste and smell by enhancing and sweetening the tobacco flavour and aroma. The inclusion of cocoa would also aid in reducing smoke irritation.

Macallan 12yr Double Cask is infused with roasted cacao beans which adds a delicate and delicious taste to the liquid. Balanced with the tobacco bitters, it has a smoky yet sweet finish to delight the senses.





# Rosebay Refreshing, floral, elegant

Rosebud Syrup, Pink Grapefruit Shrub, Violet Bitters & Alcohol-Free Sparkling Wine

While England's national flower is well known as the Tudor rose, London too has its own 'flower', rosebay willowherb; a tall plant with pretty pink flowers and leaves arranged in a spiral up its stem.

Rosebay takes inspiration from its name with the addition of rose syrup coupled with violet bitters resulting in a decidedly pink sip with delicious pink grapefruit tang.





## The Bee Project

Refreshing and sweet

Everleaf Forest, Honey Water, Lemon Juice, Chamomile Soda & Honeycomb

Many of our native pollinators are under threat from habitat loss and lack of suitable flowers across the capital. Without intervention our bees are at risk, we must do everything we can in order to save these life-giving insects.

Mixed using Everleaf, a non-alcoholic aperitif made with botanicals sourced throughout London, alongside honey and camomile. The Bee Project helps us to close the cycle, from bee to glass to bee again, with a circular economy approach.
